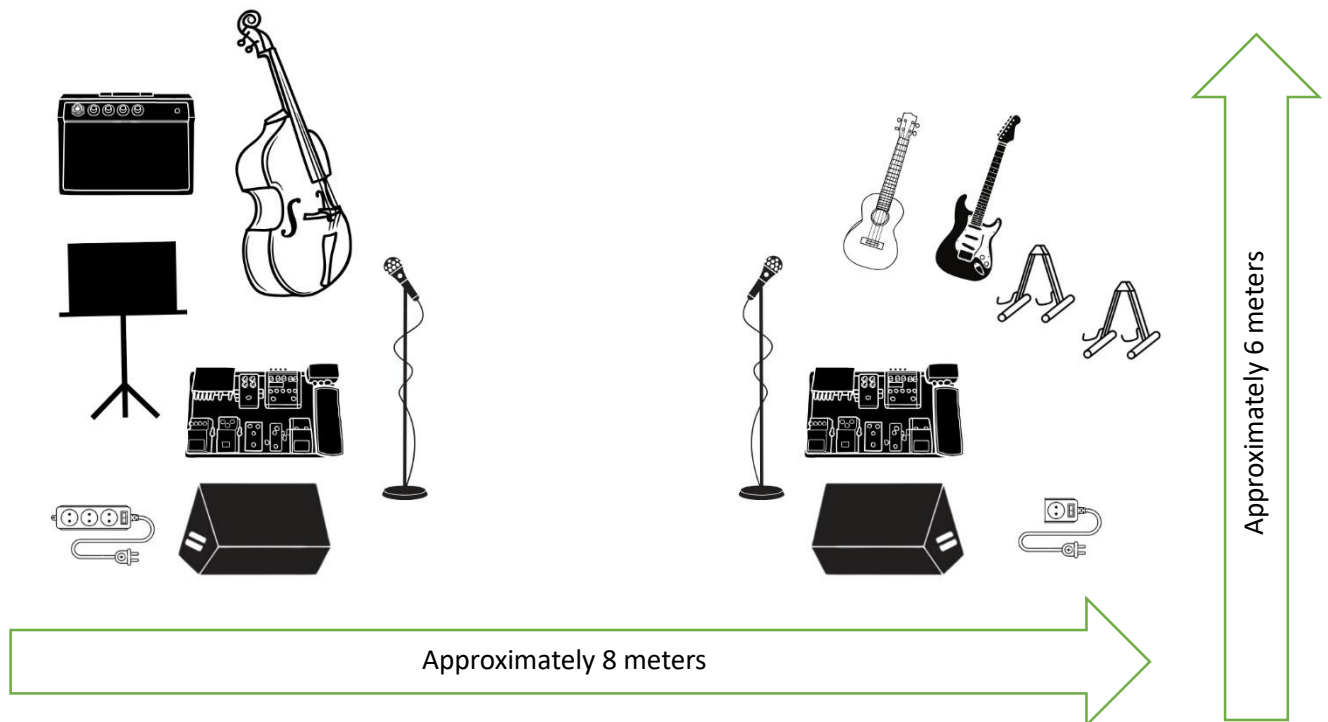


TECHNICAL RIDER AND STAGE PLAN



THE ORGANIZER IS OBLIGED TO PROVIDE:

1. An appropriate PA system and sound engineer (the size of the PA system depends on the venue capacity and the expected audience)
2. A stage with suggested size of 8x6 meters
3. Audio monitors with 12" i 15" speakers (two monitor lines)
4. Vocal microphones (Shure Beta 58 or similar, preferably with on/off switch) and mic stands
5. Microphone cables and spare cables (instrumental ¼") for musicians. Cables from the DI boxes to the mixing console must be provided.
6. Bass Amp – Gallien Kruger, Schertler, Mark Bass or similar

7. Power outlets (220V) for pedalboards (1 outlet unit for each musician) and bass amp (1 unit)
8. **Music stand (mandatory)**

SOUND CHECK

- All stage technical equipment provided by the organizer **must be fully set up before the performers arrive**, in order for the sound check to start on time.
- Stage power supply **must be protected by an RCD** and physically separated from all lighting circuits.
- Expected duration of the sound check: **60 minutes**
- Sound check start time: 2 hours before the performance (or as agreed)

RULES:

- During the sound check, only the **sound engineer and technical staff are allowed in the venue**.
- Audience members, guests, and journalists **are not allowed to attend the sound check** without prior approval from the performers.
- In case of technical difficulties or equipment failure, the musicians **reserve the right to delay the start of the concert until the issue is resolved**.
- If music is played before the sound check or performance, it must be ambient music similar to the performers' style (jazz, ethno, ethno-jazz, world music, etc.) in order to create an appropriate atmosphere and respect the artistic context of the concert.
- Audience entry into the hall is not allowed before permission is given by the musicians.

DRESSING ROOMS

The organizer must provide the musicians **one spacious dressing room or two smaller ones**, which must be clean, lockable, and **exclusively reserved for the performers**.

The dressing room must include:

- A table and a minimum of 2 chairs
- A mirror
- Clothes hangers or a clothes rack
- Access to a clean bathroom and toilet
- Two small towels
- Air conditioning or heating (depending on the season)
- Bottled water (minimum 4 bottles of 0.5 L – still and/or sparkling)



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Note: Entry for guests, audience members, or journalists is not allowed without prior consent of the performers.

LIGHTING

- A **minimum of 3 different colors** covering key areas of the stage, according to the instructions of the musicians or technician
- The lighting circuit **must be electrically separated** from the PA system, stage, and all sound sources.
- Lighting dimmers **must not produce noise** or cause interference with the sound system.

PARKING AND LOGISTICS

- Provide **1 parking space** close to the stage or entrance for technical staff
- **Separate entry** for performers and equipment (if possible)

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS

- **Secure storage space** for instruments and equipment before and after the performance
- Provide the name and mobile phone number of the person responsible for communication with the performers on the event day, as well as the technical contact person
